Bird Feeder



Recycle a milk jug and make new feathered friends with this creative nature craft for kids.

What you'll need:

Empty quart sized cardboard milk carton
Scissors
String or cord
Hole punch or pencil
Bird seed

How to make it:

Have an adult help you cut a hole in the bird feeder - it should be big enough so a bird could come and sit and eat the feed, but not too big or the carton will become unstable.

Have an adult help you punch a hole using the hole punch in the top of the milk carton and put a string through the hole. Alternatively, you can poke a hole on either side of the flap at the top of the carton by poking a pencil through the top.

Tie a knot in the string.

Fill the carton with bird seed until it reaches the top of the hole.

Hang the cart on a tree branch and watch the birds enjoy their snack!
